(To James and John)

Gentlemen, I need to speak with you.

Fishermen, right?

(They come over and he touches and smells their clothing)

Right.

JAMES AND JOHN

SARAI

Brothers?

JAMES AND JOHN

(Surprised the CSIs are so smart)

Right!

ROOKIE Too bad they're not the Farmer Brothers. I could use some coffee.

GRISSLE

(Ignoring Rookie) Can you tell us what happened here in the last 24 hours?

JAMES AND JOHN

Okay, only don't be SCARED!

The CSIs don't even flinch, of course.

JAMES AND JOHN

(Looking at each other, they start talking)

Okay, Here goes.

PLAY TRACK. CSI D. #3 - Storm Story

OR if your James and John are fast talkers,

PLAY TRACK. CSI D. #3b - Storm Story short

Rookie takes notes.

If projection is available, screens can show stormy sea, boat being tossed, etc.

JAMES

Last night, we were crossing the Sea of Galilee, and a furious storm came out of nowhere, like it does sometimes. And the waves kept beating onto the boat -

JOHN

But this time it wasn't just wind and waves - it was like the storm had a voice too. An evil howl -

(Howls)

JAMES

So even though we're experienced fishermen, we were scared to death. Even Peter was scared. Everybody was scared, except Jesus, who was Asleep!! - -

JOHN

-- Sleeping like a baby through the whole storm, mind you, while we're bailing, and screaming - -

JAMES

--And trying to keep the boat from going under --

JOHN

--Right. Finally, we screamed at him to wake up. Master, Wake up! Can't you see we're all gonna die here!?

JAMES

Yep, that's what we said.

JOHN

(James and John nod their heads.)

GRISSLE, SARAI AND ROOKIE

(Impatient for the end of this story that has caught their attention.)
